WHERE DO YOU FLY IN & OUT OF?

This tour begins on the West Coast of Newfoundland. You would fly into Deer Lake, via the Deer Lake Regional Airport (YDF). We typically recommend arriving around noon or early afternoon.

On the last day of the tour you would leave from St. John's, via the St. John's International Airport (YYT). We typically recommend departing around noon.
